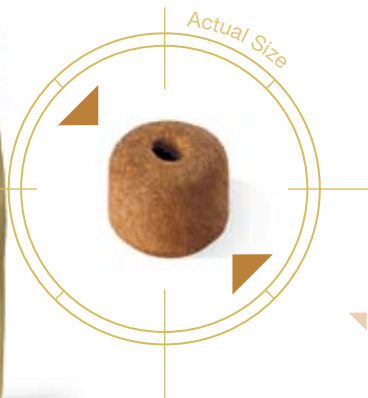

## Feeding Guide

### Recommended Daily Feeding Portion (cups per day)

Weight of Dog	Activity	Maintenance
55 - 65 lbs. (25 - 30 kg)	5-3/4 to 6-1/2	4-3/4 to 5-1/4
65 - 75 lbs. (30 - 34 kg)	6-1/2 to 7-1/4	5-1/4 to 6
75 - 85 lbs. (34 - 39 kg)	7-1/4 to 7-3/4	6 to 6-1/2
85 - 100 lbs. (39 - 45 kg)	7-3/4 to 8-3/4	6-1/2 to 7-1/4

1 cup = 8 fluid ounces = 78 grams

## Ingredients
